10+2 Program Cleared by White House and Will Now Undergo 15 Day Review

On November 6, 2008, the Office of Management and Budget finalized its review of the U.S. Customs and Border Protection proposed rule which will require Importer Security Filing information and additional data from the carriers before cargo enters into the United States. It has been made official that the White House has completed its review of the 10+2 / ISF rule and will now go into a 15 day congressional review. If all goes as planned and is passed, the 10+2 final rule could be published as early as next week in the Federal Register.
