On January 26, 2010, the Importer Security Filing, 10+2 rule, came into effect. The rule **mandates** importers of ocean cargo, or their authorized agents, to supply U.S. Customs and Border Protection with 10 additional data elements and ocean carriers to supply an additional 2 data sets. This information is to be required 24 hours prior to vessel loading in the foreign port and must be filed at this time by the Automated Broker Interface. The additional data elements reported further improves the ability of CBP to identify high-risk shipments so as to prevent smuggling and ensure cargo safety and security. **Are you complying with these requirements?**

U.S. Customs has reported that enforcement will take place in stages and starting in May, 2010, customs will begin holding cargo of non-compliant companies, and will begin other enforcement measures, including additional inspections.
