TAC ISF Web Portal and ISF Systems now updated!

An ISF is considered "filed timely" when an ISF is successfully filed 24 hours prior to loading on a vessel destine to the USA. When a shipment is placed on a feeder vessel "not" destine to the USA (and then subsequently the container is transferred to a vessel that "is" destine to the USA), the ISF is considered timely if filed 24 hours prior to loading on the mother vessel.

Noting the above, we are pleased to announce that we have enhanced our ISF Web portal, and all other ISF Systems to include additional "business references" that will accommodate both feeder and mother vessel details to better assist our clients in benchmarking ISF timeliness and compliance.
